Student Leadership

Payment to the school

When your child is bringing money to the school for any reason, please ensure it is in an envelope, with the child's name and room number on it, along with what the payment is for; fees, sports event etc.

Uniform Passes

If your child has any incorrect uniform and requires a uniform pass, they must bring a note from a parent/caregiver to the office between 8.30-8.40 to obtain a one day pass.

Pupil Absence

The school requests that parents/caregivers ring the school and inform us if your child is to be absent from school for the day. Rangeview employs an attendance officer and absentees are monitored on a daily basis. School attendance is a legal requirement and for those with continual unexplained absences the truancy officers will be notified.

Visitors to the School

We politely request that all visitors to the school report to the school office. Please do not wait outside your child's classroom at the end of the school day. Arrange for them to meet you outside the school grounds. We ask this in the interest of pupil safety as we are responsible for students while they are in our care.

School Times

Just a reminder to all parents/caregivers that the school day commences at 8.40am. Morning Interval is 10.20-10.40am. Lunch 12.40pm-1.40pm (Monday –Thursday) 12.00 –1.00 (Friday) School finishes at 3.10pm (Monday–Friday).

Allergies

As you will no doubt be aware, we have a number of children at Rangeview with severe food allergies which can lead to anaphylactic reactions. This is a life threatening condition and when an anaphylactic reaction occurs we need to administer adrenaline and call a life support ambulance immediately.

All of the class teachers will have raised this matter with their students and discussed the potential dangers related to eating peanuts, tree nuts and nut based products in certain classrooms.

We would very much appreciate your assistance with this matter and we ask that you take this information into consideration when preparing your child's lunch. Thank you for your continued support of the school in this matter.

Medication

Just a reminder to all students that if you are required to take any medication it must be handed in to the office with the student's name and required dosage on it before school. It must not be left in their school bag. The student will need to collect it again from the office at the end of the school day.

TravelWise

Welcome back to our Year 8 parents and welcome to our new Year 7 parents. For those who don't already know, we are a TravelWise school. This means that we promote sustainable methods of transport in our community and encourage our students to either walk, bike or come to school by public transport.
