Please keep this dress standards newsletter to refer to during the school year. Parents/Caregivers will be called to collect students who come to school inappropriately dressed.

### **DRESS STANDARDS: MUFTI DAYS**

We expect that students will dress appropriately for school and that they adhere to the following standards.

- No halter, strapless or backless tops, bare midriffs showing, high or stiletto heels, tee shirts with inappropriate slogans or pictures. Skirts and shorts to be of appropriate length. Hoods not to be worn up, no bandanas or beanies to be worn.
- No makeup.
- No jewellery, apart from a watch and a single, small plain ear stud worn in the lobe of each ear for the girls.
- No coloured hair or patterned cuts.
- Long hair to be tied back with a plain white, red or black headband or hair tie.
- No nail polish.
- School hats are compulsory in Terms 1 and 4, whilst they are optional in Terms 2 and 3. No other hats/ caps to be worn.
- Full PE uniform to be at school to change into for physical activities, mufti cannot be worn for PE.
