- Go for “five-in-a-row”, or “four corners” or a complete “blackout” of the whole board.





### Time Traveller

Describe a time in history that you would love to go back and visit. Why? Record your thoughts or turn them into a descriptive narrative.



### Homophone Hunt

Create a visual glossary of interesting or often misused homophones.

### It's Alive!

Choose your favourite breakfast cereal or sports ball and turn it into a "person". Write a day in the life of this new person.

### My Machine

Draw and label the parts of a machine you'd invent to prevent your family from waking you up early.

### Weird Email

If a pet could e-mail its owner, what would the email say? Write it.



### My Tribute

Create a half or full page tribute to your favourite food. Use words and pictures.

### That's Novel

Choose an excerpt from a novel that you like. Copy it, then label the different writing techniques the author uses. (You could colour code it...)

### Celebrate That Word

Find a new and/or interesting word and turn it into an acrostic poem. (Words must have 5 or more letters.)

### FREE CHOICE

Write about anything you like, in any form you like.

### A Year's Supply

List 5-10 interesting things you could do with a year's supply of jelly beans. Illustrate your ideas.



### Tongue Twisters

Write a few tongue twisters. Use alliteration (e.g. fried fish) or 'almost' alliteration techniques (e.g. funny phrase).

### Current Event Recipe

Turn a current event into a "recipe" by listing the "ingredients" and explaining how to "mix" those ingredients.

### Worst or Best?

Put one of these adjectives in front of the word **driver** and write about what comes to mind.



### How Does it Work?

Explain in detail how something works e.g. a microwave, a remote control, a light bulb, etc.

### Sell Me

Sell one of your most favourite or most hated articles of clothing by creating an advertisement for a buy and sell website.

### Family Feud

What two numbers feud the most? Record their argument. Which number wins in the end?



### Deserted Island

You're on a deserted island. You're allowed 3 books and 3 songs. Which ones would you choose and why?



### Visual Starter

Glue an image (photo, magazine clipping, etc.) onto your page. Write about it!

### Words. Words. Words.

Create a three-column word bank (nouns, adjectives, verbs) on this topic: **Writer's Words** Think of interesting, unusual, even weird words that writers might use.

### "I was totally terrified!"

Write a short narrative where this is your first sentence. Use show more than tell. Illustrate it.

### Point of View

Pretend you're an insect. Describe a room in your home from that unique point of view.



Think of something bad you've done in the last week and write an apology that sounds convincing. (If you haven't done anything bad, make something up!)



### Fake News

Make a list of seven flavours of ice cream you'd like to see invented this year. Illustrate your creations using colour.
